Upholstered commode chair


1. Characteristics

The upholstered commode chair is made of powder-coated steel frame. It has height-adjustable legs finished with non-slip rubber tips. Adjustability allows the product to be tailored to the individual patient's needs, side armrests support stability and safety in use. The chair is equipped with a toilet seat and an easily extendable plastic sanitary container. Soft, upholstered seat with backrest enhances comfort.

Set includes: chair frame with backrest, legs (4 pcs), leg pin locks (4 pcs), soft seat, sanitary container.

The set includes:

- a. chair frame
- b. soft seat
- c. legs
- d. sanitary container
- e. anti-sliding tips



2. Application

The commode chair is ancillary equipment which helps the user to perform hygienic activities. The chair is recommended to people with dysfunctions and reduced mobility who have problems with unassisted walking and for those who lost the ability of unassisted sitting down and standing up. The chair functions as a toilet owing to the toilet bucket located under the seat. The chair facilitates performing physiological activities and taking care of the user.

3. Assembly, adjustment and usage

Unfolding

Step. 1. Turn the chair frame over and insert the four legs into the mounting holes. Lock the legs using pin locks.

Step 2. Turn the chair over and place on the ground.

Note: all legs must be set at the same level. All legs should stand firmly on the ground.

Step 3. Slide the sanitary bin using the guides under the seat.

Step 4. Place the soft seat on the toilet seat.

Height adjustment

To adjust the height of the chair, pull out the pin lock, select the desired leg height, and then lock the set height with the pin lock.

The legs are adjustable in increments of 2.5 cm.

Note: all legs must be set at the same level. All legs should stand firmly on the ground

Usage

Lift the soft seat, and remove the lid of the sanitary container. After use, cover the container with the lid, and place the soft seat on the toilet seat

Note! Remember to empty the toilet sanitary container after each use.
